Land Use Planning Director Lane Shetterly to Speak at Westside Economic Alliance Breakfast Forum

WHAT: On Thursday, September 28, 2006, the Westside Economic Alliance Land Use and Housing Committee will host Lane Shetterly, Director of Oregon's Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD), as he addresses *"Planning for Our Future: What's Ahead for Oregon Land Use?"*

Shetterly will discuss some of the major land use issues currently facing our state, and present DLCD's agenda for the 2007 legislative session.

DLCD guides Oregon's statewide land use planning program, which allocates land for industrial, commercial and housing development, as well as transportation and agriculture.

Mr. Shetterly will explain how the DLCD balances these often-competing goals, and provide updates on the "Big Look" Task Force on Land Use Planning and Ballot Measure 37.
