UPDATE: Five Candidates for Oregon Governor Will Speak at Westside Economic Alliance's Bi-Partisan Debate on April 27 in Beaverton

WHAT: Democrat Party challenger Pete Sorenson will participate in Westside Economic Alliance's gubernatorial candidate debate on Thursday, April 27. Sorenson will join the leading Republican Party candidates for Governor, Jason Atkinson, Kevin Mannix, and Ron Saxton; and Independent candidate Ben Westlund. Each of the candidates will outline their respective positions and views on transportation, land use, and economic development issues in the tri-county Portland metro region.

The debate will be moderated by Westside Economic Alliance Board member and treasurer Steve Clark, publisher of Community Newspapers and the Portland Tribune. Oregon Governor Ted Kulongoski and Democratic Party challenger Jim Hill have declined to participate in this debate.
